I know, I said last week's was the last newsletter for the term but just had to do a few reminders ...

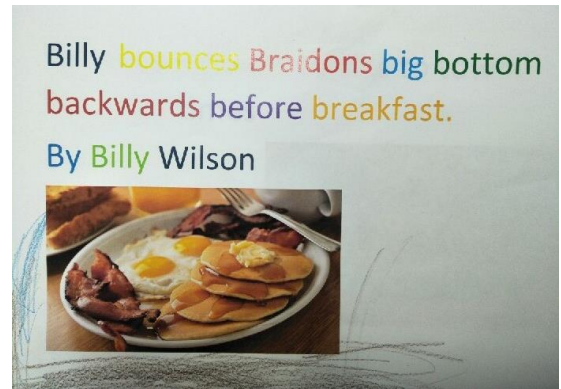
SCHOOL COUNCIL – The next school council meeting is tomorrow night.

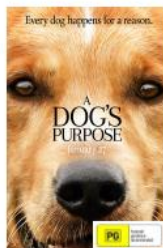
