Gr 5-6 NGV visit to see the Pharaohs Exhibition - Thanks to the **MACC Art Program** our Gr 5-6 students travelled to Melbourne today to see the Pharaoh Exhibition at the National Gallery of Victoria. The NGV has partnered with the British Museum to present Pharaoh, a landmark exhibition that celebrates three thousand years of ancient Egyptian art and culture. Through more than 500 works, including monumental sculpture, architecture, temple statuary, exquisite jewellery, papyri, coffins and a rich array of funerary objects, the exhibition unpacks the phenomenon of pharaoh, those all-powerful kings claiming a divine origin.

This should be an amazing experience and we look forward to hearing all about it on their return.
